## **ABOUT SOCIETY**

The Indian Society of Oriental Art was established in 1907 under the aegis of eminent artist Abanindranath Tagore and his elder brother Gaganendranath. Mission of the society was to impart knowledge and practice of Indian Art and to make people conscious of Art heritage of India and to make them understand and appreciate the ancient and living tradition of our art. First two teachers of the studio were revered Nandalal Bose and Khitindranath Majumdar, and the studio produced some great painters like Debiprasad Roy Chowdhury, Mukul De, Lalit Mohan Sen and Chintamani Kar among others.

## **ABOUT COURSE**

Considering the needs of present generation, Society is now imparting a three year diploma course for aspiring artists. Also, society imparts one year certificate course to such artists who desire to practice various art forms using the studio. The three year diploma course is divided into six semesters. Classes are held three days a week from 12:00 PM to 4:00 PM. Practice participants pursuing certificate course will also attend the studio thrice a week during aforesaid time.

## **EXAMINATIONS**

There will be Grade determining examination at the end of each semester. Each semester will be self-contained and it will be necessary to qualify in each semester examination to move to next. In case of failure to qualify for next semester, participant will be allowed to continue in the same semester against a readmission fee. However two consecutive failures to clear the examination will lead to discontinuance from the course. To appear in semester end examination, participants will be required to maintain at least 75% attendance.

## **ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY**

Minimum qualification to apply for admission is Madhyamik or equivalent (Class X Board examination). Minimum age should be 18 (Eighteen) years as on the date of application. There is no maximum age limit to apply. Candidates will also be required to appear in an admission test and personal interview. The admission test will be on Free hand drawing from object / model or any composition with at least three figures in pencil / pen & ink. For admission test candidates will bring their own drawing materials and drawing board of size 15 inches x 11 inches. Papers will be provided.



## **FEE STRUCTURE**

To cover the cost towards establishment, Teacher compensation and other administrative requirement society will charge minimum fees to participants as under

- a) Admission Fee ( One time ) Rs 7000.00
- b) Fee for each Semester Rs 3600.00
- c) Re admission fee Rs 2000.00
- d) Certificate Course Rs 12000.00

Cost of application form is Rs 150.00 however this cost will not be required for such applicants who will download the form from website.



## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- a) Each participant will be provided with an identity card which should always be in their possessions and displayed while they are within society premises.
- b) Participants should maintain discipline, manners and demonstrate respect to teachers, staff and officials that is befitting to the century old legacy of the society. They should not tamper with property, literature and artifacts of the society. Any unruly behavior or association with disorderly proceedings, disobedience or misbehaving inside or outside the society will attract disciplinary action which may lead to discontinuance from the course and expulsion. In such undesired eventuality, the fees paid will also be forfeited.
- c) Any student who may stay absent from classes continuously for two months or more without due approval will be deemed to have discontinued, and such participant will not be eligible for readmission. Secretary may however relax this at his discretion in special circumstances on specific representation
- d) Semester fees are payable within 15<sup>th</sup> of the month in which such fees will fall due. If the fees remain unpaid, society may strike out the name of defaulting student. Fees once paid, are neither refundable nor transferrable under any circumstances.
- e) The application form along with a signed copy of this Rules and Regulations will form a part of student record and are binding upon the participants and / or his guardian
- f) Society, from time to time, organize educational excursion, study tours, workshops. Society also organizes Annual Art Exhibition to promote artworks of student participants along with other artists of art fraternity. The semester fees do not cover these events and for participation in such events, a separate participation fee decided by society will be payable
